

L&T wins ₹7,000 cr bullet train project

Larsen and Toubro (L&T) Thursday said its construction arm has won a contract worth over ₹7,000 crore to build an 87.57-km stretch of the Mumbai-Ahmedabad bullet train line.

The project covers 17.2% of the total length, running elevated from the outskirts of

Vadodara to the outskirts of Ahmedabad in Gujarat with one station at Anand, an official statement said. National High-Speed Rail Corp. Ltd is the implementation agency for high-speed rail projects in India. The order to construct the C6 package of the high speed rail project includes the construction of viaducts, one station, major river bridges, maintenance depots, and other auxiliary works.
